## Dear Parents,

### Dental appointments are vital for your children.

In Nottingham, dental decay in children under the age of 5 is higher than the average for England. The removal of teeth is the 6<sup>th</sup> most common hospital procedure for under 5-year olds. This can lead to pain, difficulty eating and sleeping and time spent away from school. During the pandemic, many families will have missed appointments with their dentist. Please contact your nearest Dentist to get your child an appointment.

### Screen time
