Red Nose Day/Comic relief

Red nose day is an annual fundraising campaign with the mission to end child poverty by funding programs that keep children safe, healthy, educated and empowered. Safer Sleeping Week March 14-20th 2022

Safer Sleep Week is The Lullaby Trust's national awareness campaign targeting anyone looking after a young baby. It aims to raise awareness of sudden infant death syndrome (SIDS) and the safer sleep advice that reduces the risk of it occurring.

Sadly, in Nottinghamshire (city and county) there are on average 6 deaths each year of babies (up to 15 months old) that are likely to be due to an unsafe sleep environment. We need to continue to reach out to all new parents with safer sleep messages. "All a baby needs is a firm, flat sleep space that is clear of toys, bulky bedding and accessories and a simple blanket or baby sleep bag" (Lullaby Trust).
