Parent Survey feedback

Thank you to all those who took the time to complete the parent survey. We value your feedback and are working hard to act upon any issues or worries that were raised.

Q1 My child is happy and safe at nursery. 93.48% agree or strongly agree (43)

There were some parents who were unhappy about the number of agency staff that we have at nursery some days. The good news is that we have recently recruited Kelly Proctor and Laurren Butler to the team and we are advertising for an additional level two practitioner. There is a legal requirement to ensure we are always within established ratios at nursery. Covering absences and rising numbers of children can result in temporary staffing, but we work hard to employ the same practitioners and share this information with parents on the foyer notice board.

Q2 My child is well cared for at nursery. 91.3% agree or strongly agree (42)

We have reviewed our procedures for supporting children in washing their hands and faces after snacks and meal.

Q3 My child makes good progress at nursery. 89.13% agree or strongly agree (41)

Q4 Nursery makes sure my child learns how to manage their behaviour and behaviour is generally good. 89.13% agree or strongly agree (41)

Q5 The nursery is well lead and managed, including through the federation. 86.67% agree or strongly agree (39)

Q6 Nursery responds well to any of my questions or concerns. 91.30% agree or strongly agree (42)

Q7 I receive valuable information about my child's progress, from their key worker and in Evidence Me. 89.13% agree or strongly agree (41)

Our current arrangements are for one personalised Evidence Me every half term for Koalas, Lions and Pandas, with a termly observation for Penguins and Elephants. Other Evidence Me photos sent to parents are celebration events or something that is a milestone or new. We understand some parents would like more photos sent across and we will review how we can manage this.

Q8 We have been developing the nursery curriculum with a story focus. These are some of your thoughts.

"My daughter has been coming home talking about what story they are learning and we have been revisiting the same story at home. I think the nursery are doing a great job!"

"This is a job well done"

"Great, my child is getting to know the stories well"

Q9 We have been using key strategies to develop speaking. Is there anything else you would like us to help you/ your child with in this area?

"All ok and appreciation for all"
